

Things to See and Do

Day Trips:

-Take a short 15min drive to Scamander and stroll through the Winifred Curtis Scamander Reserve on easy, well marked tracks. It is home to 180 different plant species and 200 species of birds. On your way home stop at Eureka berry farm and enjoy the best of Tasmania's fruit and berries. Take a farm trail walk around the berries and then enjoy all the home made dishes including soup, salads, pasta, fruit gateaux, desserts and cakes.

-Drive inland and check out the White Knights at Fingals Evercreech forest reserve. Massive 90 metre tall white gums, some of the largest in the world. Stop and visit the amazing Mathinna falls and pass through a once thriving gold mining town. If our feeling peckish on your way home take the scenic drive down elephant pass and stop at the world famous pancake barn.

-Head about 30mins south and check out the animals at nature world. Open daily from 9am the kids can meet the local Tassie devils while the adults relax at the café. Keep heading a further 10mins south and go on a penguin tour at Bicheno. Tours leave at dusk daily and it's the best the way to see penguins up close and safely without disturbing them.

-If travelling north be sure to go see Binalong bay, and the bay of fires. The beach is one of the best in the world, so for a snorkel in the water or just get a happy snap.

-If you're a wine fanatic head down to Bicheno and Freycinet and try some the award winning wines at Apsley George and Coombend.

-Spend a day on the sea on a yacht sail around Binalong bay and Bay Of fires. Enjoy the scenery as you are tempted some fine Tasmanian seafood including crayfish, oysters and cheese.

-If your feeling up for a challenge go in land to St Mary's and climb St Patrick's head. It's a steep 2-3 hour return walk but the views from the top make it worth it.
